## Bloemershof: School, Firestation and Gym

This urban ensemble consists of three buildings, each with a different function, coming together in one mixed-use unit and comprising of a vocational school, sports hall and fire station. The ensemble is designed as an enclosed courtyard in an H-shape. The middle zone is a green and transparent public space, designed as enclosed inner courtyards and allowing views of the surrounding area. Starting with a formal garden, the green courtyards form a link with the green landscape of the Veluwe. The buildings consist of a transparent base with concrete columns, and a structure elaborated with wooden slats. Conceptually, the ensemble is designed as a 'stone forest'. The interiors are light, transparent and extremely functional.
